Program Explanation

The Youth Explore Trades Sampler is a district program that is offered in partnership between SD8 and Selkirk College. It allows you to sample and experience a variety skilled trades such as Carpentry, Electrical, Heavy Duty Mechanics, Welding, Metal Fabrication and Millwright & Machining, in an academy-style program. Your time in the course will be split between the local high school, the technical college and a work experience component. In high school classes you will learn about workplace preparation and safety aimed at young workers and visit a variety of local trades-based work sites. In college classes you will experience 10 weeks of hands-on learning in the college campus trades shops with college instructors. During the work experience portion, you will have a placement in a trade of your interest that will help you understand what working in a trade is like.

Program Requirements

- A completed application including all the required signatures from school counsellor(s), parent(s) or Guardian(s), and applicant
- The student must be registered as a student with a School District 8
- An approved graduation plan developed with a school counsellor prior to graduation, including a defined career pathway that includes the sampler program
- Completion of a Grade 10 Math credit with a minimum mark of 60%

Student Expectations

- Attend all in-school and college classes
- Act in a professional manner while on worksites and in the community
- Take it upon themselves to let instructors know when they will be late or absent
