# School District #8 Kootenay Lake acknowledges Metis Awareness Month

SD8 Kootenay Lake celebrates and honours Metis culture, history, language, music, and art through the month of November. Please join us for Metis Awareness Month and learn about Metis Peoples in Canada, in BC, and what it means to be Metis. Bring resources into your classrooms that honour the heritage and culture of Metis Peoples. Below is a starting point to be shared with all staff in the district to support Metis Awareness Month.

## Metis Flag Raising Ceremony:

- Each school in SD8 has a Metis Flag. Some keep theirs up year round, others will raise them during this month. If you want to discuss Flag Raising ceremony ideas, please connect with District Indigenization Coordinator. Please read and follow SD8 AP 400.6 Flag Protocol:
  - 1.3.2. The National Flag of Canada is always to be flown on its own mast flag protocol dictates that it is improper to fly two or more flags on the same mast (e.g. one beneath the other).
  - 5. Nations, including Indigenous Nations, as recognized by the Canadian Constitution, also have flags. Flags may be Band specific, and/or Nation specific. To display other sovereign nation flags, other than the federal and provincial flags, follow the federal and provincial guidelines for use:
    - 5.1. Flag displays in gymnasiums: The Canadian flag is the furthest to the left, followed by BC, followed by other Sovereign Indigenous Nations. Center flags so that all are in a position of honour, above the speaker.
    - 5.2. Sovereign Nation flags should not be placed in display cabinets or in classrooms, unless advised by Rightsholders for awareness purposes.
- West Kootenay Metis Society will be hosting a Metis Flag Raising Ceremony at Nelson City Hall
  on Sunday 16h November at noon. Stew and Bannock will be served outside the Nelson Museum
  Archives and Gallery afterward.
